



# United DFC 2023 Post Secondary Entrance Scholarship



United DFC greatly values our members. It is in this spirit that United DFC has established the United DFC Scholarship to recognize six (6) students from the United DFC Community Public High Schools (Auburn Drive, Cole Harbour High, Dartmouth High, École secondaire Mosaïque, Islandview High, Woodlawn) with six (6) x \$500 awards. Scholarships will be awarded based on scoring and not every high school may be represented.

### Requirements for application:

Students must be a past or present member of United DFC (past or current player, volunteer or staff) entering post secondary (University, college or trade school) for full time studies for the first time in September 2023.

Payments will be made directly to the student’s tuition account at their school. Recipients will be notified by the week of June 10, 2023.
